

## FÊTE 2010

### **Eligibility:**

Open to all local artists.

### **Theme:**

To celebrate as the hosting city of the 2010 Olympic and Paralympic Winter Games. At the same time we celebrate the cultural diversity in our society and artistic talents in our community. You are encouraged to employ artistic expression that involves the world we live in.

### **Entry Fee:**

\$20.00 Sorry, no refunds. Payable by January 19, 2009. Limit of one work per artist or artists collaboration.

### **Labels:**

All works must be labelled: on the artwork's "back" with artist's name, telephone number, selling price or insured value if NFS (Not for Sale), title and medium. Ensure NFS is very clear.

### **Presentation:**

Work must be suitably prepared for exhibition, ready for presentation. Wall mounted work must be appropriately framed or stretched with finished sides and properly wired for hanging. Work that is not properly prepared for exhibition may not be exhibited.

### **Availability:**

Work selected for exhibition must be available and must remain on display for the duration of the FÊTE 2010 exhibition: **Friday, February 12, 2010 through Tuesday 23, 2010.**

### **Sales:**

Artistree will retain a commission 30% for all works (or orders) sold. Works that are NFS should be labelled as such and should include a value for insurance purposes. The insured value of each work will be 30% less than the sale price, meaning it will not include the commission.

**\* Artists that volunteer at the exhibition for four hours or more will only require to pay a commission of 15% for art work sold. You are encouraged to be at the venue to promote your art work and the venue.**

### **Insurance:**

While every precaution will be taken to ensure the care and safety of the entries, Artistree, or any of their member, staff or volunteer workers cannot assume responsibility for loss due to damage, theft or other causes for works submitted to the jury. Insurance is the responsibility of the artist. Works selected and displayed in Lansdowne Centre during FÊTE 2010 exhibition will be covered by Artistree's insurance policy. Unrealistic claims will be questioned and must be supported in writing.
